Determination



This half term we will be focusing on our shared value of determination and the linked values of courage, patience, hope, perseverance and tenacity.


We will be reflecting on being determined to be safe, kind and the best that we can be and learning from a wide range of people who have shown determination in their lives.














We will be enjoying reading and listening to a range of stories of real life people who have been determined to make a positive contribution and show these values in abundance.

If you have had any changes to your contact details, home/mobile numbers; email address or home address; or any of your emergency contacts have changed please let the school office know.


Please also let the office staff know if you would like to change your child's meal type.

Remember you need to arrive by 8.55 am. Free breakfast is available from 8.30 for children in Reception – Class 6.


Children need to be collected on time at the end of day.


